Our November speaker, film critic Nick Nicholson, reminded us of another way to lose track of time — go see a movie! Movies play a vital role in our lives and our cultures and are usually a pleasant way to spend a few hours.

Around the world, storytelling — and the movie-going experience bring great stories to life. Today, there are more stories and more storytelling mediums than ever before. Producers and filmmakers are continually finding new talent and technologies to weave these tales. At the same time, theater owners are investing in the best ways to bring movies to life with better sound, screens, and special effects. This collaboration — and relentless innovation — among production, distribution, and exhibition is an important reason the global film industry remains strong.

Our member, Beth Garrett, who is a Regional Account Director with NCM Media Network\*, shared some movie statistics with me.

According to Beth, the movie industry could not be stronger. She says, "Cinema is and remains a uniquely immersive experience with its wall-to-wall 50-foot screens, surround sound and its dark environment." Over 750MM movie patrons per year view movies across 1600+ theatres and 20,000+ screens in the NCM network alone which doesn't include other movie theatre exhibitors, such as Landmark and Ipic. In Houston alone, NCM operates in 40 theatres across 661 screens, reaching millions every month, and that doesn't include their competition, such as Screenvision, that operates in River Oaks and a few other theatres in the Greater Houston area. Houston is ranked No. 7 in the country for movie theatres and remains strong, along with the Dallas-Fort Worth Market ranked No. 5 in the nation.

The movie-going experience is very much alive and well. Make sure to check out the new movie club information also in this month's newsletter.

It has been my pleasure and a great honor to serve this year as your president — a memorable experience for which I am grateful.




